This girl listens well and knows the sit command. She may know others and since she is food motivated could easily be taught some more. When it's time for a treat she will sit nicely alongside other dogs in the home and wait patiently for hers, showing no food or toy aggression. She's a bit of a finicky eater but loves treats. She also loves to play with toys, especially squeaky toys. She will paw at squeaky tennis balls and push them around the floor with her paws and pounce on them.
